The student or family member responsible for lesson payments must be present to complete the registration and policy forms, at the time of registration. A non-refundable fee of \$10 will reserve the student's place in the private lesson program, and will apply to any additional group program while taking private lessons. ## Tuition Payments

**Semester Plan:** one price for 13 weeks, payable in advance, or with monthly credit card auto-payment. Semester students will be invoiced for the following semester, unless they indicate their intention to withdraw 30 days prior to semester end.

FALL : October 1—December 31st

WINTER: January 2nd—March 31st

SPRING: April 1—June 30th

SUMMER: July 1st—September 30th

**Monthly Plan: \$104/ 4 weeks**

Monthly tuition is payable in advance with credit card auto-payment. Monthly students will be charged on the first of each month, unless they indicate their plan to withdraw 1 week prior.

**Trial lessons:** \$28 per 1/2 hour, payable when the lesson is scheduled.

**Summer Program:** City Music offers additional tuition options for temporary and vacationing students. These plans will be announced in the spring.



## Attendance

Studio time for our lesson instructors is scheduled well in advance. Once a lesson time has been selected, students are expected to commit to attendance on a weekly basis; lesson payments are due regardless of attendance.

A **Lesson Studio Coordinator** at each location can assist you in addressing any scheduling conflicts you may have. While absences cannot be credited or refunded, each student may re-schedule one lesson per semester, providing the request is made 24 hours in advance. Rescheduling any additional absences cannot be guaranteed. Be sure to review future schedule conflicts with our Coordinator, who will work to find a suitable lesson time for you.

Should you need to discontinue lessons altogether, please notify the Lesson Coordinator as soon as possible. Semester students need to give 30 days' notice, and will be refunded any lesson credit after the 30 days. Monthly students need to give one week's notice, and will be refunded any remaining paid lessons.

**Teacher absences and weather cancellations:** If the instructor is unable to re-schedule a lesson cancelled by themselves or by weather, an account credit will be given at the students' payment plan rate.
